## What we have done so far in d-ICT

The d-ICT partnership has already completed the e-Toolkit: "Introducing distance learning practices and digital tools to facilitate the e-Learning experience and create warm e-Classroom climate" (PR2). Every partner had to develop an e-Curriculum, an e-book with distance learning techniques and the theory underlying it and an e-tool with distance learning tools to be implemented. The contents of this e-Toolkit will be the main Modules of the micro-learning course based on the Gamified asynchronous e-Learning experience (PR3).

### 3rd Transnational Project Meeting in Paris (France), 29th June 2023

The partnership met on-site in Paris (France), hosted by AGFE. IASIS presented the progress of PR2 so far and ISQs provided the transnational templates and set the deadlines of PR3. Also, ISQe presented the content of the C-Activity in Portugal where three VET educators/trainers per partner will participate in order to test the PR2 d-ICT e-Toolkit and validate the Gamified asynchronous eLearning experience (PR3).

Moreover, the consortium agreed that the dissemination of the project should be focused on Facebook and other social media posts, publications etc. National multiplier conferences will be organized at the end of the project after all the PRs are completed and all the outputs, tangible or intangible, are delivered.
